## No. 81 of 1986

An Act to vest certain locomotives and rolling stock in the Corporation of the Town of Peterborough; and for other purposes.

[Assented to 4 December 1986]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Steamtown Peterborough (Vesting of Property) Act, 1986".

Interpretation.

2. In this Act, unless the contrary intention appears—

- "the Corporation" means the Corporation of the Town of Peterborough:
- "the deed" means the deed of sale made on 9 October, 1984, between the Society and Mrs. Mehlis by which the Society sold certain locomotives, rolling stock and other property to Mrs. Mehlis:
- "Mrs. Mehlis" means Norma Margaret Mehlis:
- "the Society" means Steamtown Peterborough Railway Preservation Society Incorporated.

Vesting of property. 3. (1) The locomotives, rolling stock and other property referred to in clauses 1 and 2 of the deed (excluding those owned by the Corporation), are vested in the Corporation.

(2) The property referred to in clause 3 of the deed that was sold by the Society to Mrs. Mehlis is revested in the Society.

(3) The locomotives, rolling stock and other property vested in the Corporation by subsection (1) shall not be sold, transferred, mortgaged or alienated in any other manner by the Corporation without the written approval of the Minister.

4. The Corporation shall pay Mrs. Mehlis the sum of \$500. Reimburgement of Mrs. Mehlis.

5. Stamp duty is not payable in respect of the deed.
