An Act to amend "The Administration and Probate Act, 1891."

[Assented to, September 23rd, 1903.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Parliament of South Australia, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Administration and Probate Short title and Amendment Act, 1903," and shall be incorporated and read with "The Administration and Probate Act, 1891," hereinafter called the principal Act.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in section 7 of the Amendment of principal Act, it shall not be necessary for the Public Trustee to be a practitioner of the Supreme Court.

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
