An Act to amend Act No. 418 of 1887, relating to
Treasury Bills.

[*Assented to, December 19th, 1891.*]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the Province of South
Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council and House of Assembly of the said province, in this present
Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. Section 6 of Act No. 418 of 1887, intituled "An Act to provide for the raising of a sum not exceeding One Million One Hundred Thousand Pounds by the issue of Treasury Bills, and for other purposes," shall be read and construed as if the words "not exceeding" had been inserted in the ninth line of that section, immediately preceding the word "Threepence."

Amendment of section
6 of Act 418 of 1887.

2. This Act may be cited as "The Treasury Bills Amendment Act, 1891," and shall be incorporated and read as one with Act No. 418 of 1887.
