An Act to amend "The Distillation Act, 1884."

[Assented to, December 5th, 1900.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Parliament of South Australia, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Distillation Amendment Act, 1900," and shall be incorporated with "The Distillation Act, 1884." Short title and incorporation.

2. The Treasurer may grant licences to distil eucalyptus oil to persons applying for such licences, and who enter into bonds with two sureties to be approved by the Treasurer in the sum of One Hundred Pounds, conditioned that the still shall be used for distilling eucalyptus oil only and that the obligor will obey the provisions of "The Distillation Act, 1884," the Acts amending the same, and the regulations for the time being in force thereunder. Licences to distil eucalyptus oil.

3. Licences under this Act may be in the form in the Schedule hereto, and shall be for one year only, and a fee of Ten Shillings shall be paid for each licence. Form of licence and fee.

In the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
