An Act to amend "The Destitute Persons Act, 1881," and "The State Children Act, 1895."

[Assented to, October 30th, 1903.]

E it Enacted by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Parliament of South Australia, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Destitute Persons and State Short title. Children Acts Amendment Act, 1903," and shall be incorporated and read with "The Destitute Persons Act, 1881," and "The State Children Act, 1895," and all Acts amending either of the said Acts.

2. Section 10 of "The Destitute Persons Act, 1881," is amended Orders under by adding the words "the Secretary or some other officer of the State Children's Council, or to "between the words "to "and " such "

Officer of the Council. in the eighth line of the said section, and by adding after the word "use" in the ninth line the words "or for her maintenance," and such amendments shall have effect as from the time when the said Act came into operation.

Section 83 of "The State Children Act, 1895" is hereby State Children Act amended by adding after the word "Council" in the ninth line the amended so that orders may be made words "or to the Secretary or some other officer of the Council," to any officer of the and such amendment shall have effect as from the time when the said Act came into operation.
