An Act to further amend 'The Sale of Food and Drugs Act, 1882," and for other purposes.

[Assented to, October 30th, 1903.]

B it Enacted by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Parliament of the State of South Australia, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Food and Drugs Further Short title. Amendment Act, 1903," and shall be read and incorporated with "The Sale of Food and Drugs Act, 1882" (hereinafter called the principal Act), and all Acts amending the same.

2. Every inspector appointed pursuant to the provisions of The inspector section 4 of "The Food and Drugs Act Amendment Act, 1890," appointed by the Governor to have the shall be appointed by the Governor, and such inspector shall powers of a local inspector. have and exercise throughout the State all the powers and authorities conferred upon any officer or local inspector under the principal Act.

3. Every officer appointed by the Government under the said Government analyst section 4 for the purpose of making any analysis shall have and powers as a local exercise throughout the State all the exercise throughout the State all the powers and authorities of an analyst. analyst appointed by a local authority under the said Act.
