An Act to amend "The Insolvent Act, 1886."

[Assented to, November 23rd, 1887.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said province in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. Section 21 of "The Insolvent Act, 1886," is hereby amended by the insertion of the words "The Local Court of Palmerston" after the words "The Local Court of Mount Gambier" in the second line of the said section. Preamble.

2. This Act shall be retrospective and "The Insolvent Act, 1886" shall be read and construed as if the words now inserted in the said section had originally been inserted, and had always occurred therein. Amendment of section 21 of Act 385 of 1886.

In the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill. Act to be retrospective.
