An Act to extend the operation of Jury Lists in Local Courts.

[*Assented to, August 13th, 1902.*]

BE it Enacted by the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Parliament of South Australia, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Jury Act Amendment Act, 1902," and shall be incorporated and read with "The Jury Act, 1862," and all Acts amending the same. Short title.

2. The Jurors Rolls now in use in the Local Courts of the State shall continue in operation and be valid and effectual for all purposes for a period of three years from the passing of this Act. Local Courts Jury Lists to continue in force.
