An Act to amend "The Municipal Corporations Amendment Act, 1903."

[*Assented to, December 1st, 1909.*]

**B**E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Municipal Corporations Further Amendment Act, 1909." Short title.

2. This Act is incorporated and shall be read as one Act with "The Municipal Corporations Amendment Act, 1903" (hereinafter called "the said Act"). Incorporation with Act 833 of 1903.

3. Section 14 of the said Act is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following paragraph, namely— Amendment of sec. 14 of the said Act.

xiv. The laying down or renewal of streets with wood blocks, asphalt, channel iron, or other improved pavements. Paving of streets.

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
