An Act to amend the Trespassing on Land Act, 1951.

[Assented to 2 May 1985]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Trespassing on Land Act Amendment Act, 1985".

(2) The Trespassing on Land Act, 1951, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out the passage "twenty dollars" and substituting the passage "five hundred dollars";

and

(b) by striking out the passage "forty dollars" and substituting the passage "one thousand dollars".

leave.

3. Section 6 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out the passage "forty dollars" and substituting the passage "one thousand dollars";

and

(b) by striking out the passage "eighty dollars" and substituting the passage "two thousand dollars".

address.

4. Section 7 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the passage "forty dollars" and substituting the passage "one thousand dollars".

Amendment of  
s. 8—  
By whom  
requests can be  
made.

5. Section 8 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the passage "forty dollars" and substituting the passage "one thousand dollars".
