## No. 1098.

An Act to enable the Corporation of the City of Port Adelaide to join in the scheme of Municipal Electric Tramways authorised by "The Municipal Tramways Trust Act, 1906."

*[Assented to, December 14th, 1912.]*

**B**E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Port Adelaide Electric Tramways Act, 1912." Short title.

2. This Act is incorporated with "The Municipal Tramways Trust Act, 1906" (hereinafter called "the principal Act,") and the principal Act and this Act shall be read together as one Act. Incorporation.

3. On and from the passing of this Act:—

Port Adelaide tramways.

(a) The Corporation of the City of Port Adelaide shall be a Suburban Corporation and shall be subject to the same liabilities and have the same rights as if originally included as a Suburban Corporation in the principal Act; and the definition of "Suburban Corporations" in section 3 of the principal Act shall be read as including the said Corporation:

(b) For the purposes of subdivision (b) of subsection (1) of section 50 of the principal Act, the assessed annual value

value of ratable property in the Municipality of the City of Port Adelaide shall be taken as One Hundred and Fifty-seven Thousand Pounds:

- (c) The definition of "Town Clerk" in section 3 of the principal Act shall be read as including the Town Clerk, or the person for the time being performing the duties of the Town Clerk, of the Municipality of Port Adelaide:
- (d) The moneys required for or in connection with the exercise by the Trust of the power, conferred by section 30 of the principal Act, to purchase the tramways and undertaking referred to in section 56 of the "Port Adelaide and Suburban Tramway Act, 1877" shall be included in the meaning of the term "the cost of purchase," and the provisions of the principal Act as to the cost of purchase shall apply thereto.

4. The present members of the Trust appointed by the Corporations of the City of Unley and the Towns of Kensington and Norwood, St. Peters, Hindmarsh, and Thebarton shall, subject to the provisions of the principal Act, continue to hold office for the balance of the periods for which they were appointed respectively, but the Corporation of the City of Port Adelaide shall be entitled to take part in every appointment of a member by the Suburban Corporations after the passing of this Act.

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
