# GEORGII V REGIS.

An Act to authorise the Treasurer to raise Moneys to the amount of Four Millions Seven Hundred and Thirty-two Thousand Pounds for various Public Works, and for other purposes.

[*Assented to, December 7th, 1910.*]

**B**E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

**1.** This Act may be cited as "The Public Purposes Loan Act, 1910." Short title.

**2.** The Treasurer may raise money to the amount of Four Millions Seven Hundred and Thirty-two Thousand Pounds, by the issue and sale of South Australian Inscribed Stock or Treasury Bills, such Stock and Bills, bearing not more than four per centum annual interest, interest payable half-yearly: Provided that the repayment of the principal thereof shall not extend beyond thirty years from the time of issue. Power to borrow.

**3.** All sums of money raised under this Act shall be applied to the several purposes set forth in the Schedule hereto, and to the extent therein set forth; and shall be applied by the Treasurer in such amounts and manner as the Governor, by warrant under his hand, countersigned by the Chief Secretary, may from time to time authorise and direct. Salaries to be submitted to Parliament.

4. All salaries of officers payable out of moneys raised under this Act shall be annually submitted to Parliament.

Advances.

5. The Governor may, by warrant, countersigned by the Chief Secretary, authorise the Treasurer to advance to the proper Responsible Minister of the Crown, for the purposes of this Act, any sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum hereby authorised to be raised; and an amount equal to the sums of money so advanced shall be retained by the Treasurer out of any moneys raised by him under the authority of this Act, and applied in repayment of the moneys so advanced.

Expenses incurred.

6. All discounts, charges, and other expenses incurred in connection with the issue of the securities sold under this Act shall be charged to an account constituted for the purpose of paying discounts, charges, and other expenses incurred in connection with the floating of loans, and such account shall be credited annually with contributions from General Revenue, not being less than ten per centum of the amount of the expenses incurred in raising the money authorised to be raised under this Act.

Expenses of carrying out Act No. 896 of 1905.

7. All discounts, charges, and other expenses already incurred or to be incurred in connection with the securities issued under "The Redemption of Public Securities Act, 1905," and all other expenses of carrying out the purposes of the said Act, shall be charged to the account mentioned in section 6 of this Act, and such account shall be credited annually with contributions from the General Revenue not being less than ten per centum of the amount of the discounts, charges, and other expenses mentioned in this section.

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
