An Act to amend "The Robertstown Railway Act, 1911." [Assented to, November 14th, 1912.]

THEREAS it is desirable to alter the route for the railway by Preamble. "The Robertstown Railway Act, 1911," provisionally authorised to be constructed, and in consequence of such alteration to enlarge the Railway District constituted by that Act: And whereas in contemplation of such alteration and enlargement the poll by that Act required to be taken has not yet been taken— Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as "The Robertstown Rail-Short titles. way Act Amendment Act, 1912."
- (2) "The Robertstown Railway Act, 1911" (hereinafter called No. 1070 of 1911. "the principal Act"), and this Act may be cited together as "The Robertstown Railway Acts, 1911 and 1912."
- 2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and the Acts Incorporation with incorporated therewith, so far, as regards the last-mentioned Acts, as they are severally applicable, but with the exceptions stated in the First Schedule to the principal Act.

3. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended by striking out of Amendment of subdivision 1. thereof the words "'Walter Rutt, Chief Engineer for Act_ Railways,' and dated the second day of September, one thousand Substitution of new nine hundred and eleven," and inserting in lieu thereof the words "'J. C. B. Moncrieff, Chief Engineer for Railways,' and dated the twenty-sixth day of September, nineteen hundred and twelve."

Amendment of section 5—Limit of cost.

4. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the word "Thousand" in the seventh line thereof the words "Four Hundred."

Amendment of section 10—Date for poll of ratepayers.

5. Section 10 of the principal Act is amended by substituting "The Robertstown Railway Act Amendment Act, 1912," for the words "this Act" in the first line thereof.

Consequent amendments.

- 6. Wherever the expression "The Robertstown Railway Act, 1911," occurs in--
 - (a) Section 11, subsection (1), paragraph xv;
 - (b) The Second Schedule; and
 - (c) The Fourth Schedule

of the principal Act, the expression "The Robertstown Railway Acts, 1911 and 1912" is substituted in lieu thereof.

Amendment of section 36—
When guarantee provisions to end.

7. Section 36 of the principal Act is amended by substituting the word "five" for the word "ten" in the first line thereof.

Amendment of Fifth Schedule— New plan substituted. 8. The Fifth Schedule to the principal Act is amended by substituting the plan in the Schedule to this Act for the plan in the said Fifth Schedule.
