An Act to amend the Travelling Stock Waybills Act, 1911-1956.

[Assented to 25th August, 1960.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Travelling Stock Short titles.
Waybills Act Amendment Act, 1960".

(2) The Travelling Stock Waybills Act, 1911-1956, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Travelling Stock Waybills Act, 1911-1960".

(3) The Travelling Stock Waybills Act, 1911-1956, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Incorporation.
Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

3. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection :— Amendment of principal Act, s. 5—

(3) In any proceedings for an alleged offence relating to the delivery of any stock to a drover to be conveyed within any hundred contrary to this section it shall be a sufficient defence if the defendant satisfies the court—

(a) that the stock were delivered to be conveyed at a time between one half hour before sunrise and one half hour after sunset ; and

Waybill for stock.

(b) that the stock were delivered to be conveyed
to a place distant not more than twenty miles
from the place of departure of the stock.
