An Act to amend the Vermin Act, 1914.

[Assented to, November 5th, 1931.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Vermin Act Amendment Short titles. Act, 1931 ''.
- (2) The Vermin Acts, 1914 to 1930, and this Act may be cited together as the "Vermin Acts, 1914 to 1931".
- (3) The Vermin Act, 1914, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- 2. Section 71 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the Amendment of words "once in one of the newspapers published in the State and" principal Act, s. 71in the first and second lines thereof.

Advertising of balance-sheet.

3. Section 150 of the principal Act is amended by adding at the Amendment of end thereof the following subsection:-

principal Act,

(3) The Commissioner may in respect of any such difference as Reference of aforesaid by notice in writing delegate to any person all or any of differences between the authorities or powers conferred upon the Commissioner by this section (including the power to make a decision as aforesaid), and such person shall thereupon have and may exercise such delegated authorities and powers.
