An Act to amend "The Vermin Districts Act, 1894."

[Assented to, December 19th, 1896.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Parliament of South Australia, as follows:

- 1.** This Act may be cited as "The Vermin Districts Amendment Act, 1896," and shall be incorporated with "The Vermin Districts Act, 1894," hereinafter called the principal Act. Short title and incorporation.
- 2.** It shall not be necessary for persons nominated for election to a Vermin Board, under section 23 of the principal Act, to be residents in the district. Members of Board need not be residents in district.
- 3.** The rate declared by the Board under section 83 of the principal Act may exceed Four Shillings, but shall not exceed Ten Shillings per square mile of the ratable property within the district. Rate may exceed Four Shillings per square mile.
- 4.** It shall suffice if not less than three persons shall be appointed as the Vermin Board in any district. Three persons may form Board.
