### No. 26 of 1959

An Act to amend the Vine, Fruit, and Vegetable Protection Act, 1885-1936.

[Assented to 26th November, 1959.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Vine, Fruit, and Vegetable Protection Act Amendment Act, 1959".
- (2) The Vine, Fruit, and Vegetable Protection Act, 1885-1936, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Vine, Fruit, and Vegetable Protection Act, 1885-1959".
- (3) The Vine, Fruit, and Vegetable Protection Act, 1885-1936, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of principal Act, .8.

Powers of inspectors.

- 3. Section 8 of the principal Act is amended—
  - (a) by striking out the words "or upon any vessel" therein and inserting in lieu thereof the words "or into or upon any vessel, train, aircraft, vehicle, carriage, or conveyance";

(b) by inserting therein before the words "examine and remove" the words "search for,".
