An Act to amend the Veterinary Surgeons Act, 1935-1952.

[Assented to 26th September, 1957.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Veterinary Surgeons Act Amendment Act, 1957". Short titles.

(2) The Veterinary Surgeons Act, 1935-1952, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Veterinary Surgeons Act, 1935-1957".

(3) The Veterinary Surgeons Act, 1935-1952, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 17 of the principal Act is amended by inserting therein after subsection (1) thereof the following subsection:—

(1a) If the board is satisfied on the production of a certificate from the registrar or other officer of a university in the Commonwealth of Australia that a person has passed the examinations prescribed by that university for admission to a degree or diploma in veterinary surgery but has not yet been admitted to that degree, the board may, upon payment of a fee of three guineas and upon being satisfied that, if the person had been admitted to the degree or diploma, he would be entitled to be registered as a veterinary surgeon, temporarily register that person as a veterinary surgeon.

Any such temporary registration shall, unless extended, remain in operation until the expiration of one month after the next meeting of the said university held for the purpose of conferring degrees or, as the case may be, diplomas in veterinary surgery takes place, or until the person temporarily registered becomes registered as a veterinary surgeon under this Act, whichever first occurs.

The board may, if it thinks that just cause exists for doing so, extend the operation of any such temporary registration for such period as it thinks fit.

While a temporary registration granted under this subsection remains in force it shall have the same effect in all respects, except as to renewal, as registration granted under subsection (1) of this section.

3. Section 21 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out the word "two" in the second line thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "three".

(b) by striking out the word "two" in the fifth line thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "three".

4. Section 28b of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "one" in the second line of subsection (2) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "two".
