An Act to authorise the Commissioner of Waterworks to construct a Main Pipe from the Hope Valley Reservoir to the Yatala Labor Prison, and for other purposes.

[Assented to, 30th November, 1878.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to authorise the Commissioner of Waterworks to construct a main pipe from the Hope Valley Reservoir to the Yatala Labor Prison, and other works connected therewith; and whereas plans and sections showing the source of supply, and the direction of said main pipe, and the other works, and the lands on or through which the same are to be constructed or pass, and also books of reference containing the names of the owners or occupiers, or reputed owners or occupiers (so far as known), of any private lands on which the said works will be constructed, or through which they will pass, have been deposited in the office of the Surveyor-General, at Adelaide—Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor of the Province of South Australia, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. It shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Waterworks to construct the main pipe and other works according to the said plans and sections, and to enter upon the lands delineated and described respectively in the said plans and sections and books of reference, and to break the surface of such lands for the purpose of constructing and laying and fixing thereunder the said main pipe and other works, and, from time to time, to enter upon the said lands and break the surface thereof for the purpose of laying down, taking up, repairing

repairing, relaying, or examining the said main pipes, and other works, and erecting any valve building, edifice, or other works.

Commissioner to pay compensation.

2. The Commissioner of Waterworks shall pay compensation to the owners of the said lands, and the amount of such compensation, and the manner of payment thereof, shall be determined in manner provided in the "Lands Clauses Consolidation Act," and an Act No. 26 of 1855-56, intituled "An Act to amend the Lands Clauses Consolidation Act," which Acts, for such purpose, are hereby incorporated herewith.

Errors and omissions in plans, &c., may be corrected by Justices, &c.

3. If any error, omission, misstatement, or wrong description shall have been made of any lands, or of the owners and occupiers, or reputed owners or occupiers, of any lands delineated or shown on the said plans or sections, or described in the books of reference deposited as aforesaid, the Commissioner of Waterworks, after giving ten days' notice to the owners or occupiers, or reputed owners or occupiers, of the lands affected, or likely to be affected, by the correction of such error, omission, misstatement, or wrong description, may apply to two Justices to correct the same; and, if it shall appear to such Justices that it is expedient and not unjust to correct such error, omission, misstatement, or wrong description, they shall give the said Commissioner a certificate in such form as they shall think proper, and shall in such certificate state the particulars of any such error, omission, misstatement, or wrong description; and such certificate, with the documents to which it refers, shall be deposited with the other documents to which they refer, in the office of the Surveyor-General, and thereupon such plans, sections, or book of reference shall be deemed to be correct according to such certificate, and the said Commissioner may make, complete, extend, and maintain the works hereby authorised, in accordance with such certificate, as if such error, omission, misstatement, or wrong description had not been made.

Surveyor-General to receive plans and allow inspection.

4. The Surveyor-General shall keep the said plans and sections, and books of reference, and all other documents deposited with him, for the purposes of this Act, and shall allow all persons interested to inspect any of the documents aforesaid, and to make copies and extracts of and from the same.

Interpretation.

5. In the construction of, and for the purposes of this Act and "The Adelaide City, Port, and Suburban Waterworks Act, 1874," when not inconsistent with the context, the expression, the "undertaking" shall, in addition to the meaning assigned thereto by the said "The Adelaide City, Port, and Suburban Waterworks Act, 1874," mean and include the main-pipe and other works hereby authorised to be constructed.

Short title.

6. This Act may be cited for all purposes as "The Waterworks Further Amendment Act, 1878."

Waterworks Further Amendment Act.—1878.

7. Except so far as the same is inconsistent with or altered by this Act, this Act and “The Adelaide City, Port, and Suburban Waterworks Act,” shall be incorporated and read as one Act. Incorporation.
