An Act to amend the Width of Tires Act, 1923.

[Assented to, November 6th, 1930.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Width of Tires Act, 1930". Short titles.
(2) The Width of Tires Acts, 1923 to 1925, and this Act may be cited together as the "Width of Tires Acts, 1923 to 1930".
2. This Act is incorporated with the other Acts mentioned in sub-section (2) of section 1 of this Act and those Acts and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.
3. Section 16 of the Width of Tires Act, 1923, is amended so as to read as follows: Amendment of Width of Tires Act, 1923, s. 16—
16. (1) The Governor may make regulations restricted in their application to any road or roads named therein, or any part or parts of the State described therein, prescribing for vehicles or motor vehicles or any class of vehicles or motor vehicles a maximum weight which may be carried on any such vehicle or motor vehicle or on the axle thereof, lower than that fixed by or under section 4 or section 6 of this Act. Such regulations may definitely fix the maximum weight applicable to Alteration of maximum loads.

Width of Tires Act.—1930.

to any case or may prescribe the method by which the said maximum weight is to be calculated and may differentiate between vehicles having different kinds of tires.

(2) Any maximum weight so fixed shall, subject to the restrictions aforesaid, be deemed to be substituted for that fixed by or under the relevant provisions of section 4 or section 6.
