Issu and application of £1,103,943 18s. 11d. 2 The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue, and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fortyfive, the sum of one million one hundred and three thousand nine hundred and forty-three pounds eighteen shillings and eleven pence.

Appropriation of supplies. 7 & 8 Geo. VI. No. 94 and 8 Geo. VI. No. 2. **3** All sums granted by this Act, the Supply Act 1944-45, and the Supply Act (No. 2) 1944-45, out of the Consolidated Revenue towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty, amounting, as appears by the first schedule, in the aggregate to the sum of one million eight hundred and seventy-seven thousand four hundred and thirty-three pounds eighteen shillings and eleven pence, are appropriated and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of those Acts for the purposes and services expressed in the second schedule to this Act.
