

APPROPRIATION.

No. 39 of 1948.

AN ACT to grant and apply a Sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the Service of the Year ending on the Thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and forty-nine, and to appropriate the Supplies granted for that Year in this Session and the preceding Session of Parliament.
[10 November, 1948.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title. **1** This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation Act 1948-49*.

Issue and application of £4,532,493 7s. 7d. **2** The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-nine, the sum of four million five hundred and thirty-two thousand four hundred and ninety-three pounds seven shillings and seven pence.

Appropriation of supplies. Nos. 31 and 38 of 1948. **3** All sums granted by this Act and the *Supply Acts 1948-49*, out of the Consolidated Revenue towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty, amounting, as appears by the first schedule, in the aggregate to the sum of five million eight hundred thousand three hundred and forty three pounds seven shillings and seven pence, are appropriated and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of those Acts for the purposes and services expressed in the second schedule to this Act.
