

## APPROPRIATION, 1951-52.

No. 58 of 1951.
AN ACT to grant and apply a Sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the Service of the Year ending on the Thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-two, and to appropriate the Supplies granted for that Year in this Session of Parliament. [1 November, 1951.]
$\mathbf{B}^{\boldsymbol{E}}$ it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

Short title.

Issue and application of $\mathfrak{£} 4,891,974$

1 This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act 1951-52.

2 The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-two, the sum of four million eight hundred and ninetyone thousand nine hundred and seventy-four pounds.

Appropriation of

3 All sums granted by this Act and the Supply Act 1951-52, out of the Consolidated Revenue towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty, amounting, as appears by the first schedule, in the aggregate to the sum of six million, five hundred and sixty thousand eight hundred and seventyfour pounds, are appropriated and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of those Acts for the purposes and services expressed in the second schedule to this Act.
