- (e) by omitting from subsection (9) the words “, and periodical elections shall be held every year”.

AN ACT to amend the *Audit Act 1918*.
[26 June 1958.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Audit Act 1958*.

(2) The *Audit Act 1918*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of July 1957.

2 Section five of the Principal Act is repealed and the following section is substituted therefor:—

“ 5—(1) The Auditor-General shall be paid a salary at the rate of three thousand two hundred pounds a year.

Salary of

(2) The salary of the Auditor-General shall be paid out of the Consolidated Revenue which, to the necessary extent, is appropriated accordingly.

(3) No addition to, or deduction from, the salary payable pursuant to this section shall be made in order to meet variations in the cost of living.”
