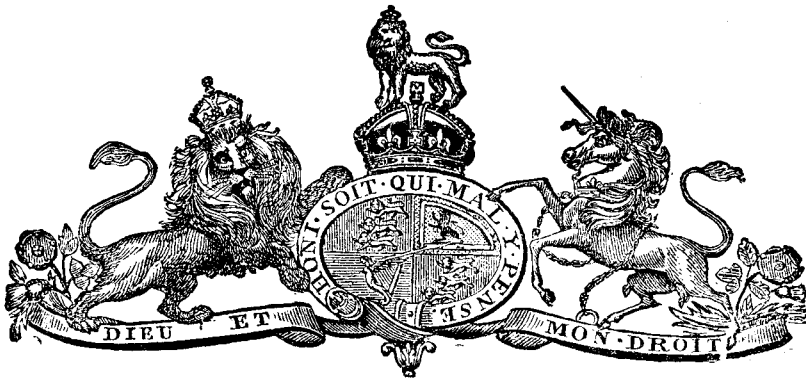

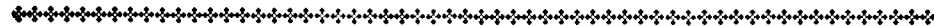

2 There may be appropriated, issued, and applied out of the consolidated Revenue for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, for the several purposes specified in the schedule, any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of seven thousand five hundred and twenty-eight pounds three shillings and four pence, but so that the amount to be appropriated, issued, and applied for each of the purposes so specified shall not exceed the sum set out in the schedule in respect thereof.
