

APPROPRIATION (No. 2) 1959-1960.

No. 20 of 1960.

AN ACT to appropriate and apply a sum from the Consolidated Revenue to the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June 1960.

[20 June 1960.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation Act (No. 2) 1959-1960.*

Issue and application of moneys.

2 The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June 1960 the sum of £12,400.

Appropriation of supplies.

3 The sum issued and applied pursuant to section two is appropriated for the purposes expressed in the schedule.
