

## APPROPRIATION (No. 2) 1960-1961.

No. 63 of 1960.

AN ACT to appropriate and apply a sum from the Consolidated Revenue to the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June 1961.

[5 December 1960.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation Act (No. 2)* Short title.  
1960-1961.

**2** The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June 1961 the sum of £7,000. Issue and application of moneys.

**3** The sum issued and applied pursuant to section two is appropriated for the purposes expressed in the schedule. Appropriation of supplies.

AN ACT to approve an Agreement relating to the sale of the undertaking carried on by the Australian Aluminium Production Commission at Bell Bay in this State, to authorize the Treasurer to take up shares in, or debentures of, the company to which that undertaking is proposed to be sold, and to provide for matters incidental thereto.
