AN ACT to amend the Auctioneers and Estate Agents Act 1959.
[17 December 1975]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Auctioneers and Estate Agents Act 1975*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Auctioneers and Estate Agents Act 1959*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Times for
auctions.

2 Section 24 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsection (4) and substituting the following subsection:—

“(4) This section does not apply to—

- (a) an auction of any land the plans of which have been displayed conspicuously for at least two clear days before the auction takes place in the premises at which it takes place; or
- (b) an auction of property (other than land, livestock, or wool) where the property has been available for public inspection for 7 hours before 6 p.m. on the day of the sale.”.
