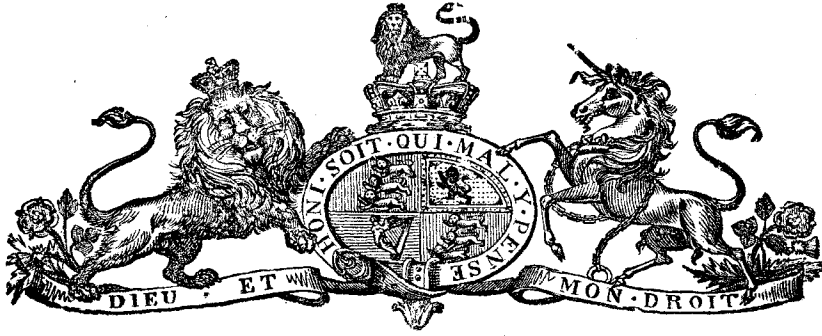

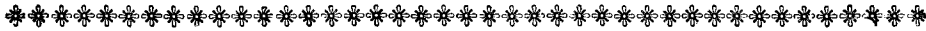

AN ACT further to amend *The Launceston Corporation Act.* [29 September, 1865.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

It shall not be lawful for any Justice of the Peace to act or sit as Justice at any Court of Special General Sessions held within the Municipality of *Launceston* for the purpose of hearing Appeals against Assessment who is either an Appellant or Agent for any Appellant in any Appeal to be heard at such Court.
