

## AN ACT further to amend The Launceston [29 September, 1865.] Corporation Act.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

It shall not be lawful for any Justice of the Peace to act or Sessions to be sit as Justice at any Court of Special General Sessions held within the Municipality of Launceston for the purpose of hearing Appeals against Assessment who is either an Appellant or Agent for any Appellant in any Appeal to be heard at such Court.
