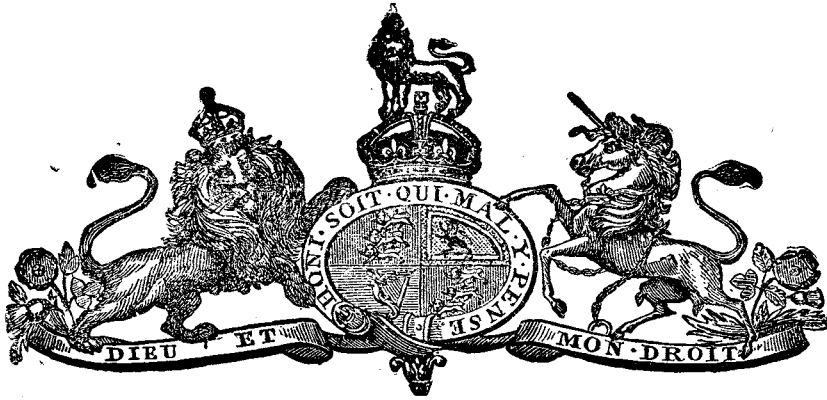

ANALYSIS.

- 1. Provision as to references in Acts, &c., to Engineer-in-Chief in case of abolition of office of Engineer-in-Chief.

AN ACT respecting references in Acts to the Office of Engineer-in-Chief, and for other purposes. [14 January, 1919.]

A.D. 1918.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 Where—

- i. In any Act : or
- ii. In any regulations, rules, or by-laws made under any Act : or
- iii. In any proclamation—

whether passed or made before or after the commencement of this Act, any reference is made to the Engineer-in-Chief or to the office of the Engineer-in-Chief, such reference shall, in case of the abolition of the office of Engineer-in-Chief, be construed as a reference to such officer or to such office as the Governor, by proclamation, may, from time to time, designate for the purpose.

The Governor may, from time to time, by proclamation, cancel or alter any proclamation made by him under this section.
