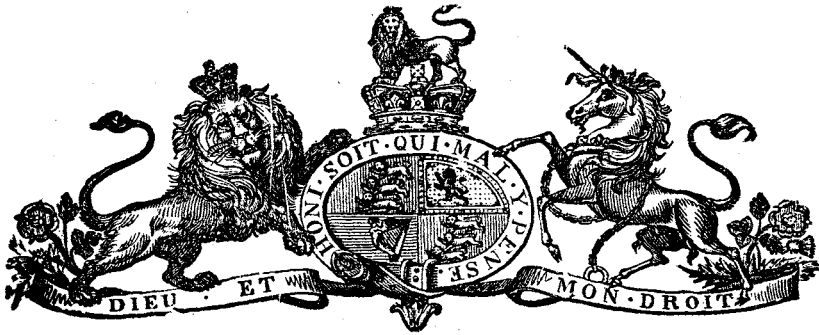

AN ACT Supplementary to the Act for appropriating a certain Sum arising from the Land Revenue to the Service of the Colony of *Tasmania* for the Year 1865.

[11 October, 1867.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 Out of the Land Fund of the Colony of *Tasmania* there shall and may be appropriated, issued, and applied, in the manner hereinafter provided, for the purpose hereinafter mentioned, a sum of money not exceeding in amount the sum of money hereinafter specified; that is to say,

2 The Treasurer of the said Colony shall issue and pay the said sum to such person for the purpose hereinbefore mentioned, upon such day as the Governor for the time being by any Warrant or Order in writing to be signed by him shall order and direct; and the payment so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Land Revenue of the Colony.

**3** The said Treasurer shall in his Accounts be allowed credit for the said sum so paid by him in pursuance of such Order or Warrant in writing as aforesaid; and the receipt of the person before mentioned to whom the same shall be so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for such sum and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

**4** The said sum shall not be issued or applied to any use, intent, or purpose other than that mentioned.
