*AN ACT to amend an Act passed in the Fourth Year
of the Reign of Her present Majesty intituled An Act
for the making altering improving and defining the
Main and other Roads of this Island.*

WHEREAS the said recited Act is inoperative by reason of the second proviso in the Thirty-third Section thereof and it is expedient that the said Thirty-third Section should be repealed—

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by His Excellency SIR JOHN EARDLEY EARDLEY-WILMOT Baronet Lieutenant-Governor of the Island of Van Diemen's Land and its Dependencies with the advice of the Legislative Council that from and after the passing of this Act the Thirty-third Section of the said recited Act shall be and the same is hereby repealed.

II. AND BE IT ENACTED that at the meeting for the Election of Commissioners to be holden as provided by the Thirty-second Section of the said Act every person of full age and not subject to any legal incapacity who shall be entitled either in fee or for life or as lessee or assignee to any lands or tenements whether of freehold or any other tenure whatever within the District for which such Election shall take place and having a beneficial interest therein of the clear yearly value of Ten Pounds over and above all rents and charges shall be entitled to vote at such Election—PROVIDED that no person whatsoever shall be admitted to vote at such Election who has not at least Four Days before the day on which such Election shall take place registered his

qualification to vote with the Police Clerk in such District for which registration such Police Clerk shall be entitled to a fee of One Shilling and no more.

III. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that after the first Election of Commissioners under this Act no person shall be admitted to vote at any subsequent or other Election of Commissioners who has not at least Four Days before the day on which such subsequent or other Election shall take place registered his qualification to vote with the Police Clerk of the District for which such Election shall take place who shall be entitled for such registration to receive a fee of One Shilling and no more and who has not also paid to the person authorised to receive the same under the said recited Act the sum assessed by any previously elected Commissioner or Commissioners on the Annual Rental or Annual Valued Rental of his land buildings and tenements as the case may be.
