

AN ACT to amend "An Act to provide for A.D. 1891. reimbursing Members of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly their Expenses in relation to their Attendance in Parliament." $\lceil 10 \mid November, 1891. \rceil$

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :-

1 Section Three of the Act of the Parliament of Tasmania, intituled Substitution or "An Act to provide for reimbursing Members of the Legislative Section 3 of Council and House of Assembly their expenses in relation to their 54 Vict. No. 20. Council and House of Assembly their expenses in relation to their attendance in Parliament," 54 Victoriæ, No. 20, is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof the following shall be and be deemed to be and may be cited as Section Three of the said Act; that is to say:—

"The amount payable per annum to any Member under the provisions of the said Act shall be paid to him in Two equal sums of Fifty Pounds each, and one of such sums shall be paid to him as soon as he shall have attended Twenty sittings of the Legislative Council or the House of Assembly, as the case may be, and the other of such two sums shall be paid to him at the end of the Session of Parliament in each year during the period that such Member shall continue to be a Member of the Legislative Council or House of Assembly, as the case may be: Provided always, that if any Member shall die, or resign, or otherwise cease to be a Member of Parliament after he has received one of such two sums in any year and before he has received the other such sum payable in the same year, his successor shall be entitled to receive only the second of such two sums payable in that year."
