

AN ACT to appropriate a certain Sum arising from the General Revenue to the Service of the Colony of Tasmania for the Year 1866.

[29 September, 1865.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 Out of the General Revenue of the Colony of Tasmania there shall and may be appropriated, issued, and applied, in the manner hereinafter provided, for the purpose hereinafter mentioned, any sums of money not exceeding in amount the sum of money hereinafter specified; that is to say,

s. d.For the Queen's Plates to be run for at New Town and 200 0 0

2 The Colonial Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sum Moneys payable to such persons for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, upon such by Warrant of the days and in such proportions as the Governor, by any Warrant under Governor. his hand, from time to time, orders and directs; and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the General Revenue.

Credit to be given in Treasurer's Accounts.

3 The said Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his Accounts for any sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such Warrant as aforesaid; and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for any such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
