AN ACT to apply a certain Sum for and A.D. 1889.
towards the Construction of the *Emu Bay*
Breakwater. [4 February, 1889.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 It shall be lawful for the Minister of Lands and Works to expend a sum not exceeding Five thousand Pounds out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose for and towards the erection, construction, and completion of the *Emu Bay* Breakwater: Provided that the Minister shall not expend any part of the said sum of Five thousand Pounds unless and until the *Van Diemen's Land* Company shall have contributed One thousand Pounds and the *Table Cape* Marine Board shall have contributed Eight hundred Pounds respectively for and towards the erection, construction, and completion of the said Breakwater.

Minister to cause Works to be constructed.
