

AN ACT to authorise a Loan of Four thousand A.D. 1904. Pounds to the Board of the Town of Devonport, in accordance with the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890." [11 *November*, 1904.]

DE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor to grant, in accordance with Governor may the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890," a sum grant loan of of Four thousand Pounds as a loan to the Board of the Town of \$\frac{\mathcal{L}}{24000}\$ under Devonport, for the purposes of "The Devonport Lighting Act, 1900," \$\frac{\mathcal{L}}{64}\$ Vict. No. 30. \$\frac{\mathcal{L}}{64}\$ Vict. No. 45. and such sum of money shall be defrayed out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose: Provided always, that it shall not be necessary for the Board to comply with the proviso to Section Two of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890," but, before any part of the said sum is advanced as aforesaid, plans and specifications of the proposed works shall be submitted to and approved of by the Governor.
