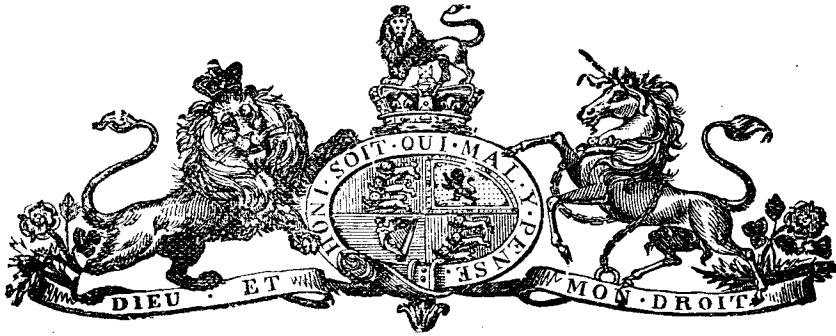

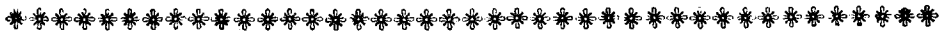

AN ACT to authorise a Loan of Five A.D. 1896.  
thousand Pounds to the Marine Board of  
*Mersey*, in accordance with the provisions  
of "The Local Public Works Loans Act,  
1890." [23 October, 1896.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to grant, in accordance with the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890," such sum of money not exceeding Five thousand Pounds, as a Loan to the Marine Board of *Mersey*, for Harbour Improvements; and such moneys shall be defrayed out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose: Provided always, that the proviso to Section Two of the said Act shall not apply to the Loan authorised by this Act.
