

ANALYSIS.

1. Amendment of Section One of the Principal Act.

AN ACT to amend "An Act to authorise the 1912. Loan of certain Sums of Money to the Municipality of Glenorchy, and for other purposes." [17 December, 1912.]

HEREAS it is desirable to amend "An Act to authorise the Preamble. Loan of certain Sums of Money to the Municipality of Glenorchy, and 9 Ed. VII. for other purposes" (which Act is hereinafter referred to as "The No. 24. Principal Act"), by increasing the amount which may be granted by the Governor as a loan to the Warden, councillors, and electors of the Municipality of Glenorchy for the purposes of the Principal Act from One thousand six hundred Pounds to Three thousand Pounds:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

1 Section One of the Principal Act is hereby amended by deleting Amendment of from the Second and Third lines thereof the words "One thousand six Section One of hundred," and substituting therefor the words "Three thousand."
