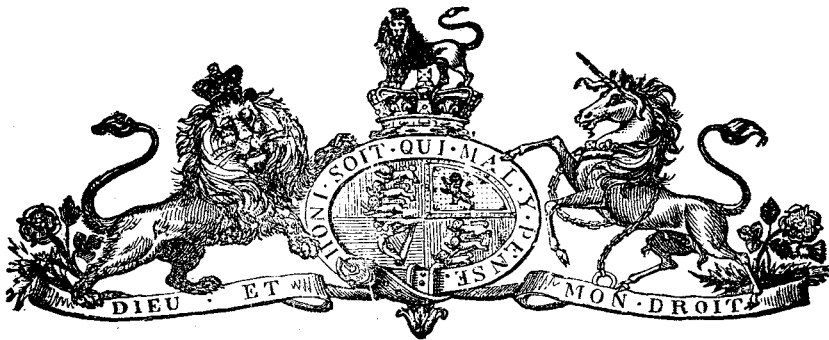

AN ACT to apply certain Sums of Money for A.D. 1892.
and towards the Construction of Telegraph
Lines and the Extension of Telephonic
Communication. [21 December, 1892.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 The unexpended balances of moneys appropriated by the Acts of the Parliament of *Tasmania* named in the Schedule for and towards the items as mentioned in the said Schedule, to the amounts therein set forth, shall and may be applied by the Treasurer in and towards the construction of Telegraph Lines under *The Electric Telegraph Act*, and the extension of Telephonic Communication under “*The Telephone Act, 1882.*”
