



AN ACT to allow *Michael Roache* to select a Piece of Crown Land, and to authorise the Issue of a Grant for the same. A.D. 1891.

[23 December, 1891.]

WHEREAS *Michael Roache* selected a piece of Crown Land, and, having failed to pay the instalments thereon, the Land thereby became forfeited to the Crown, together with the instalments paid thereon, to the amount of One hundred and thirty-one Pounds Eighteen Shillings and Sixpence: PREAMBLE.

And whereas it is desirable that the said *Michael Roache* should be permitted to select another piece of Crown Land of the value of the instalments forfeited to the Crown:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for the said *Michael Roache* to select and acquire a piece of Crown Land to the value of One hundred and thirty-one Pounds Eighteen Shillings and Sixpence, and the said *Michael Roache* shall be deemed to have paid for such land the sum of One hundred and thirty-one Pounds Eighteen Shillings and Sixpence, notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in "The Crown Lands Act, 1890," or any other Act. *Michael Roache* may select land. 54 Vict. No. 8.

2 Under and subject to the various provisions contained in "The Crown Lands Act, 1890," and any Regulations made and published thereunder, the Governor may, if he thinks fit, in the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, convey and alienate in fee simple, or for any less estate or interest, any Crown Land selected under the preceding Section by the said *Michael Roache*. Governor may issue Grant of such land.
