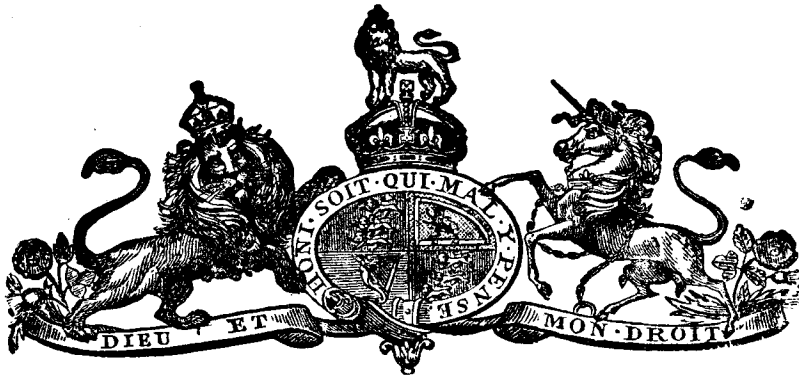

AN ACT to amend "The North-Eastern Harbour Trust Act, 1913," and for other purposes. A.D. 1917.
[8 February, 1917.]

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend "The North-Eastern Harbour Trust Act, 1913," by increasing the amount which may be granted by the Governor as a loan to the North-Eastern Harbour Trustees for the purposes of the said Act, from Three thousand Pounds to Three thousand two hundred and fifty Pounds : PREAMBLE.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

Amendment of

1 Sections Twenty-one, Twenty-two, and Twenty-nine of "The North-Eastern Harbour Trust Act, 1913," hereinafter referred to as "The Principal Act," are hereby amended by omitting from each of the said sections the words "Three thousand Pounds" wherever occurring therein, and substituting for the words so omitted the words "Three thousand two hundred and fifty Pounds."

Previous poll to
be sufficient.

2 The Poll taken on the Thirtieth day of November, One thousand nine hundred and fifteen is hereby declared to be sufficient for the purposes of the Principal Act and Amending Act as amended by this Act.

Retirement of
of Trustees.

3—(1) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Principal Act, the Trustees who should under the provisions of the Principal Act retire from office on the First Wednesday in the month of July in this year, shall, after the passing of this Act, retire instead on the Fourth Thursday in the month of April in this year.

(2) Thereafter the retirement of Trustees under the provisions of the Principal Act shall take place on the Fourth Thursday in the month of April in each year instead of on the First Wednesday in the month of July in each year, and the provisions of Section Nine of the Principal Act shall be read as if the words "Fourth Thursday in the month of April" were inserted in the said section in lieu of the words "First Wednesday in the month of July" therein appearing.
