

AN ACT to apply out of the Consolidated A.D. 1889. Revenue Fund the Sum of Sixty thousand

Pounds to the Service of the Colony of Tasmania for the Month ending the Thirtyfirst day of January, 1889.

[10 January, 1889.]

DE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony of Tasmania Appropriation. there shall and may be appropriated, issued, and applied, in the manner hereinafter provided, for the service of the Colony for the month ending the Thirty-first day of January, 1889, any sums of money not exceeding in the whole the Sum of Sixty thousand Pounds: Provided that no payments for any Establishment or Service be made other than in accordance with the amounts voted for similar Establishments or Services on the Estimates for the Half-year ending the Thirty-first day of December, 1888.

Appropriation, Consolidated Revenue Fund, £60,000.

Moneys payable by Warrant of the Governor. 2 The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said several sums to such persons for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor, by any Warrant under his hand, from time to time, orders and directs; and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

Credit to be given to the Treasurer in Accounts. 3 The said Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his Accounts for any sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such Warrant as aforesaid; and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for any such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
