

AN ACT to apply out of the Consolidated A.D. 1891. Revenue Fund the Sum of Two hundred thousand Pounds to the Service of the Colony of *Tasmania* for the Nine Months ending the Thirtieth day of *September*, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-one.  $[11 \ July, 1891.]$ 

**T**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony of Tasmania Issue and applithere shall be issued and applied, from time to time, for the Service of cation of the Colony of Tasmania, for the Nine months ending the Thirtieth day of September, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-one, the sum of Two hundred thousand Pounds, for the purposes expressed in the Schedule to the Act of Parliament 54 Victoria, No. 57.

2 The said sum of Two hundred thousand Pounds shall be in Money in addition addition to the sum of Four hundred and fifty thousand Pounds voted to former Vote. by the said Act of Parliament 54 Victoria, No. 57; and notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the said Act, any money appropriated by the said Act may be applied from time to time for and towards similar Establishments or Services for the Nine months ending the 30th September, 1891.

3 This Act and the said Act shall be read and construed together as Acts to be read one Act.
