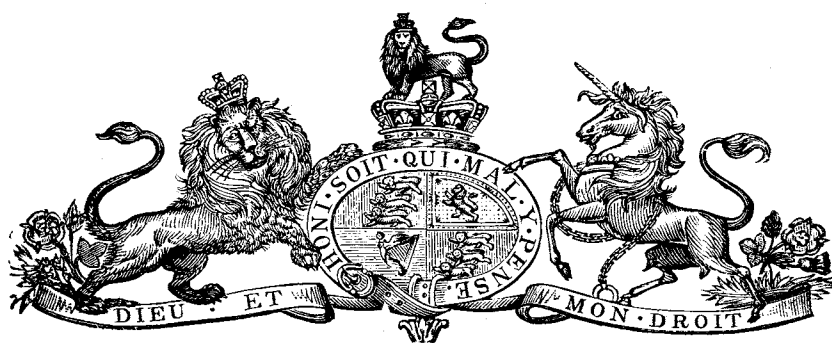

AN ACT to approve of the Municipal Council of the Rural Municipality of *Ross* borrowing a Sum of Money to defray the Cost of building a Town Hall in the Town of *Ross*.  
[23 December, 1891.]

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Rural Municipality of *Ross* have built a Town Hall in the Town of *Ross*, and are desirous of obtaining a sum of money as a loan under the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890:"

And whereas it is necessary that such work should be first approved of by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** It shall be lawful for the Municipal Council of the Rural Municipality of *Ross* to borrow any sum or sums of money not exceeding One thousand Pounds for the purpose of defraying the cost of building a Town Hall in the Town of *Ross*.

Municipal Council of *Ross* may borrow money to build Town Hall.

**2** Notwithstanding anything contained in "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890," it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to grant a loan not exceeding One thousand Pounds to the Municipal Council of the Rural Municipality of *Ross*, under and subject to the provisions of the said Act, to defray the cost of building the said Town Hall.

Loan may be made under 54 Vict. No. 30.
