

AN ACT to approve of the Municipal Council A.D. 1891. of the Rural Municipality of Ross borrowing a Sum of Money to defray the Cost of building a Town Hall in the Town of Ross. $[23 \ December, \ 1891.]$

W HEREAS the Municipal Council of the Rural Municipality of PREAMBLE. Ross have built a Town Hall in the Town of Ross, and are desirous of obtaining a sum of money as a loan under the provisions of "The 54 Vict. No. 30. Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890:"

And whereas it is necessary that such work should be first approved of by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

1 It shall be lawful for the Municipal Council of the Rural Municipality of Ross to borrow any sum or sums of money not exceeding One thousand Pounds for the purpose of defraying the cost of building a Town Hall in the Town of Ross.

2 Notwithstanding anything contained in "The Local Public Loan may be Works Loans Act, 1890," it shall be lawful for the Governor in made under Council to grant a loan not exceeding One thousand Pounds to the 54 Vict. No. 30. Municipal Council of the Rural Municipality of Ross, under and subject to the provisions of the said Act, to defray the cost of building the said Town Hall.
