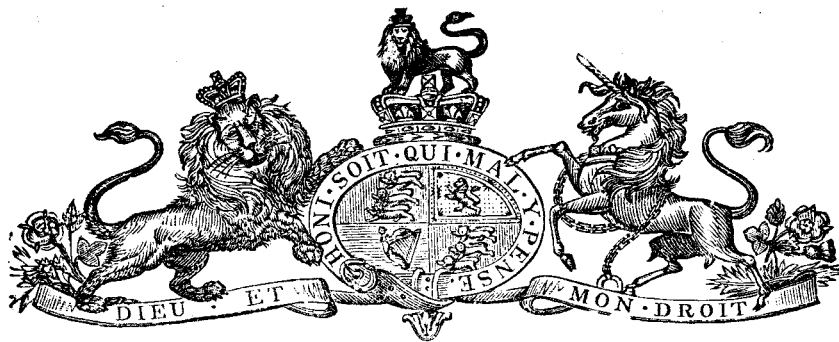

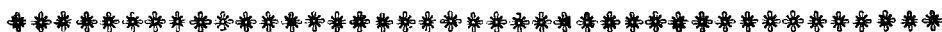

AN ACT to approve of the Municipal Council of the Rural Municipality of *Ross* borrowing a Sum of Money to defray the Cost of providing Buildings for Police purposes in the Town of *Ross*. [23 October, 1896.] A.D. 1896.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Rural Municipality of *Ross* are desirous of obtaining a sum of money as a loan under the provisions of "The Local Public Loans Act, 1890," for the purpose of providing buildings for Police purposes in the Town of *Ross* : PREAMBLE. 54 Vict. No. 30.

And whereas it is necessary that such work should be first approved of by Parliament :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 It shall be lawful for the Municipal Council of the Rural Municipality of *Ross* to borrow any sum or sums of money not exceeding Three hundred Pounds for the purpose of defraying the cost of providing buildings for Police purposes in the Town of *Ross*. Municipal Council of *Ross* may borrow money to build Police buildings.

2 Notwithstanding anything contained in "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890," it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to grant a loan not exceeding Three hundred Pounds to the Municipal Council of the Rural Municipality of *Ross*, under and subject to the provisions of the said Act, to defray the cost of providing buildings for Police purposes in the said Town. Loan may be made under 54 Vict. No. 30.
