

AN ACT to approve of the Municipal Council A.D. 1896. of the Rural Municipality of Ross borrowing Sum of Money to defray the Cost of providing Buildings for Police purposes in the Town of Ross. [23 October, 1896.]

W HEREAS the Municipal Council of the Rural Municipality of PREAMBLE. Ross are desirous of obtaining a sum of money as a loan under the provisions of "The Local Public Loans Act, 1890," for the purpose of 54 Vict. No. 30. providing buildings for Police purposes in the Town of Ross:

And whereas it is necessary that such work should be first approved of by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 It shall be lawful for the Municipal Council of the Rural Muni- Municipal cipality of Ross to borrow any sum or sums of money not exceeding Council of Ross Three hundred Pounds for the purpose of defraying the cost of providing buildings for Police purposes in the Town of Ross.

may borrow money to build Police buildings.

2 Notwithstanding anything contained in "The Local Public Loan may be Works Loans Act, 1890," it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council made under to grant a loan not exceeding Three hundred Pounds to the Municipal 54 Vict. No. 30. Council of the Rural Municipality of Ross, under and subject to the provisions of the said Act, to defray the cost of providing buildings for Police purposes in the said Town.
