AN ACT to authorise the Appropriation of a A.D. 1882. Sum of £20,000 towards the Cost of Improvements in the *Hobart* Rivulet.

[9 October, 1882.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer, out of moneys to be provided £20,000 to be by Parliament for that purpose, to advance and pay to the Municipal payable for works

Council of the City of *Hobart* any sum or sums of money not exceeding in *Hobart*Rivulet. in the whole the sum of Twenty thousand Pounds (£20,000), in and towards the construction and completion of certain works and improvements in and upon the Hobart Rivulet in the said City.

2 No moneys shall be payable under this Act unless the said Council No moneys to be shall submit to the Minister of Lands and Works for the time being such particulars, estimates, plans, and specifications of the works proposed ticulars of prosuch particulars, estimates, plans, and specifications of the works proposed works to be performed as the Minister deems necessary, and the Governor in furnished to Council shall approve of such works.

3 Upon the receipt by the said Treasurer from time to time of a Treasurer to pay certificate by the Engineer-in-Chief that any such works or any part thereof have been well and properly performed, and stating the total cost the same, there shall be payable to the said Council under this Act Chief. such sum or sums of money as the Governor in Council may approve, not exceeding two-thirds of the total cost of any such works or any part thereof, and not exceeding in the whole the said sum of Twenty thousand Pounds (£20,000).
