

AN ACT to authorise the Appropriation of A.D. 1891. certain Moneys in aid of the Police Expenditure in certain Municipalities. [23 $\bar{D}ecember$, 1891.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 There shall be payable by the Treasurer out of the Consolidated Appropriation in Revenue Fund in the year 1892 to the Municipal Council of every aid of Police Expenditure in the Pound upon penditure in certain Municipal Council of every the annual value of the property within the Municipality shall be insufficient to defray the Police Expenditure for that year in such Municipality, a sum equal to the amount by which such Expenditure, or so much thereof as shall be certified by the Commissioner of Police to be necessary, shall exceed the amount of such Rate in the same year: Provided that the total amount to be expended under this provision shall not exceed the sum of Four thousand Pounds.

2 No sum of money shall be payable or paid under the provisions of Limit of the last preceding Section to the Municipal Council of any Municipality application of which does not make and levy in the year 1892 a Police Rate of Nine-preceding Section, pence in the Pound upon the annual value of the property within the Municipality.
